Their professionalism, dedication, and expertise were instrumental in securing this win, and we extend our deepest gratitude to them for their exceptional service.

This ruling is a testament to the strength of our legal system and its capacity to uphold justice and fairness. The CPP remains committed to our values of democracy, justice, and integrity, and we will continue to work tirelessly for the betterment of our party and our country.
